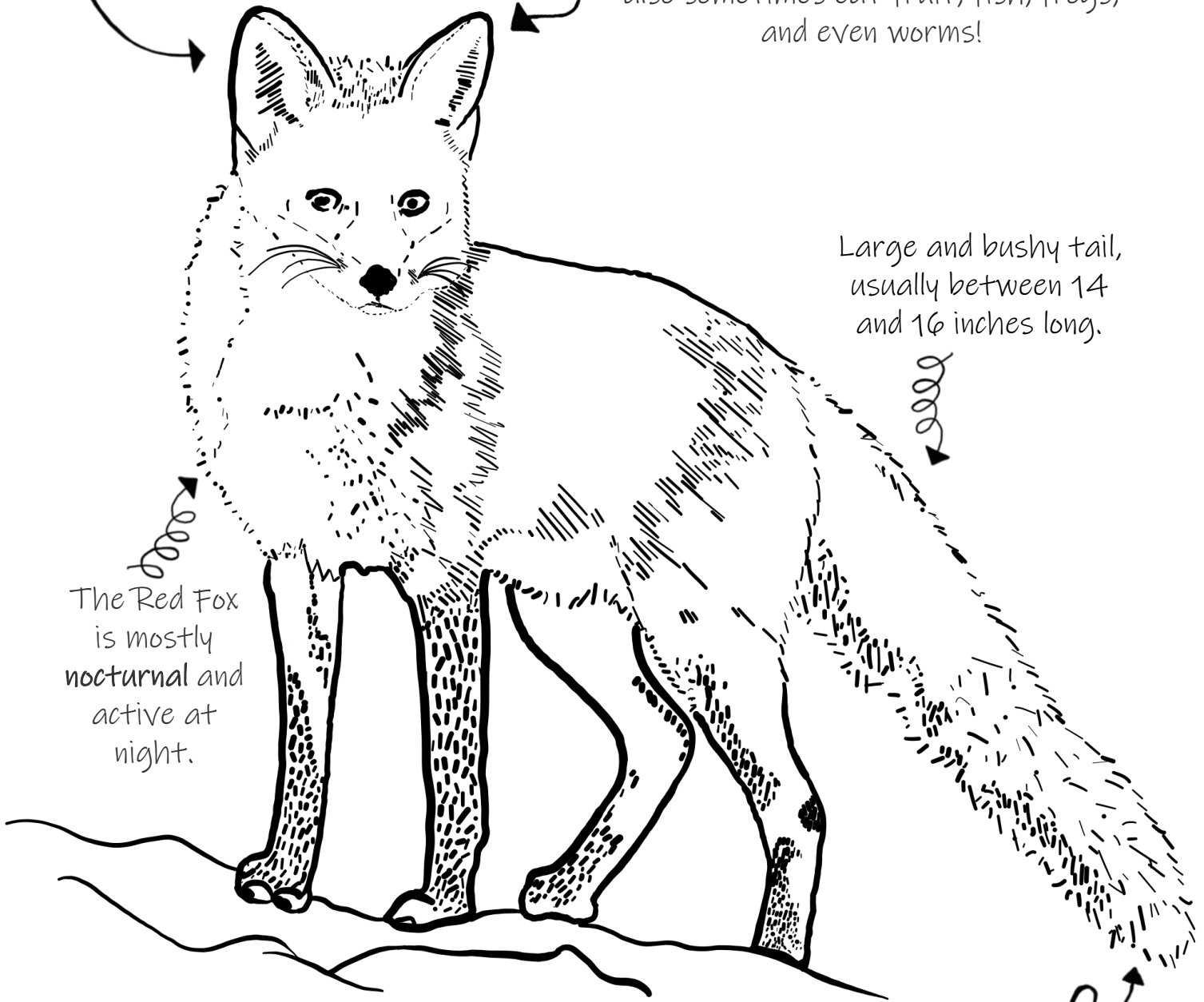


Get to Know: The Red Fox

Vulpes vulpes

Red Foxes have great senses. They can even hear their prey moving underground!

Their diet includes rabbit, rodents, birds, and other small animals. They also sometimes eat fruit, fish, frogs, and even worms!



Large and bushy tail, usually between 14 and 16 inches long.

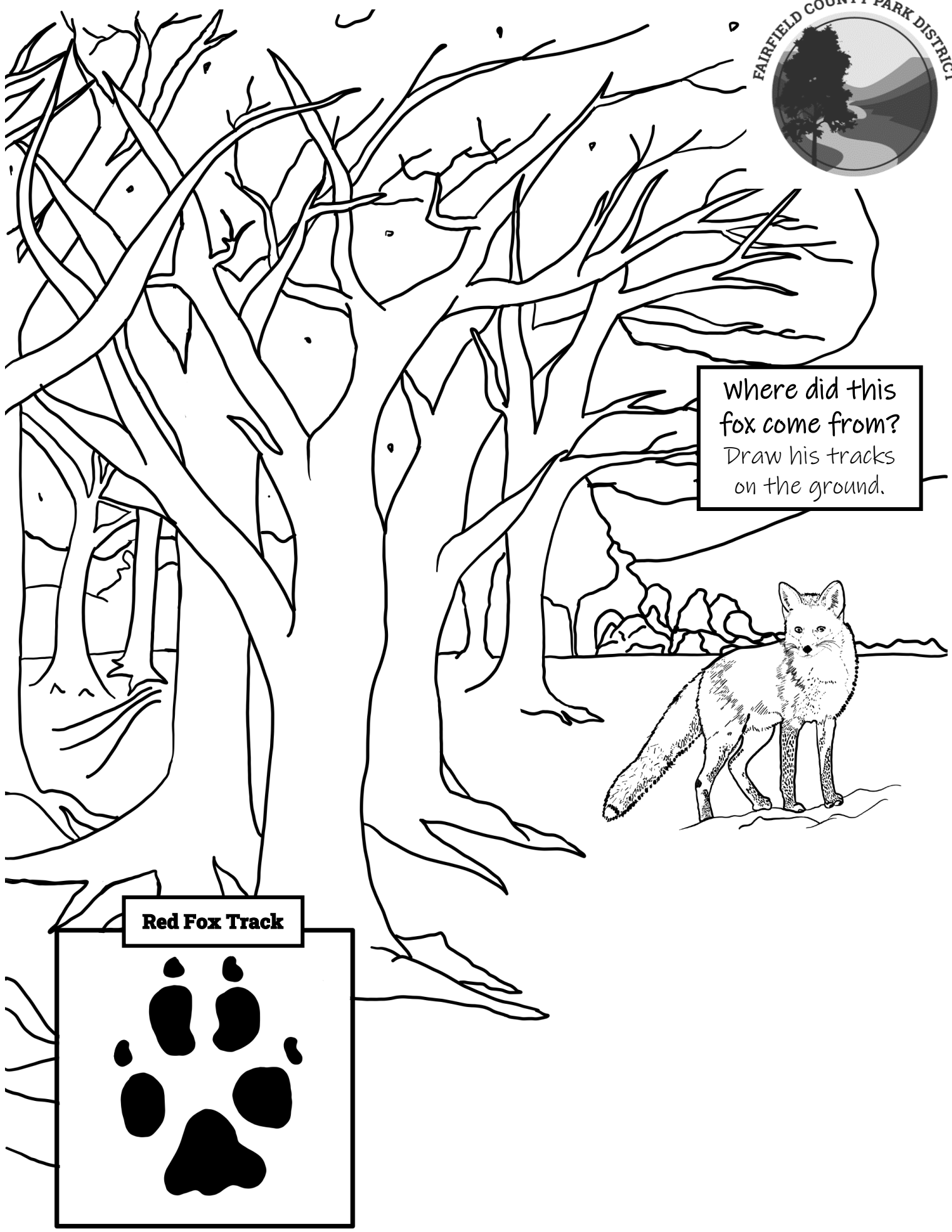
The Red Fox is mostly nocturnal and active at night.

Red Foxes are typically reddish orange with black legs, but they can also have a silver coloration.

White on tip of tail.

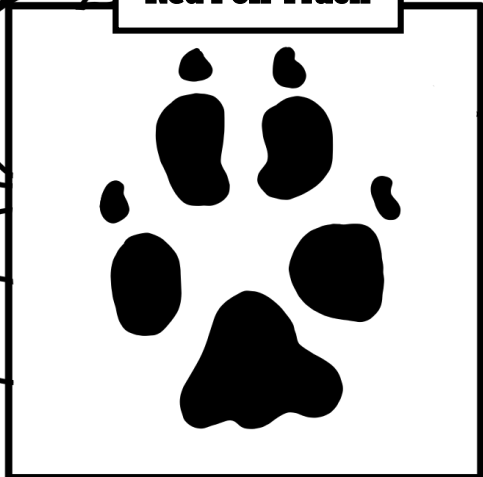

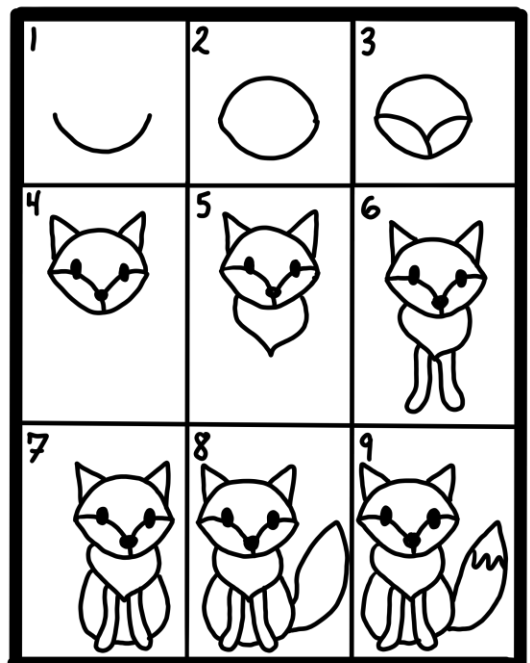
Where did this fox come from?

Draw a Red Fox

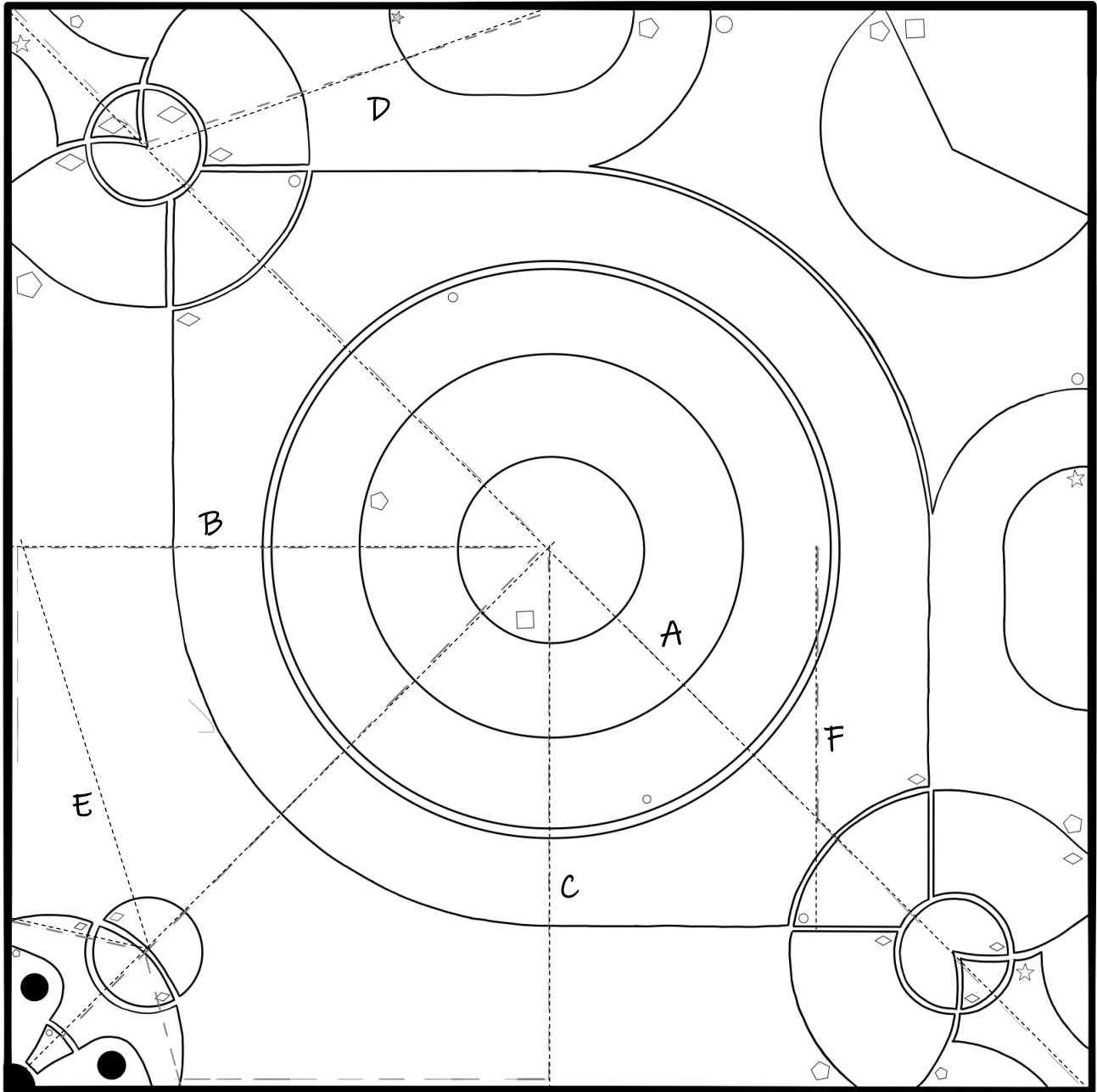
Follow the steps to draw a red fox, or create your own!





Origami Red Fox

Color the design using this guide: Orange Brown Mustard (dark yellow)
 Gray White



- 1) Carefully cut out design along thick black line.
- 2) Fold down along dotted line marked **A** so design is on outside
- 3) Fold down along dotted lines marked **B** and **C**
- 4) Fold down along dotted line **E**. Then punch down the fox's head as shown in diagram 5.

5) Fold along line **F** to create tail.
