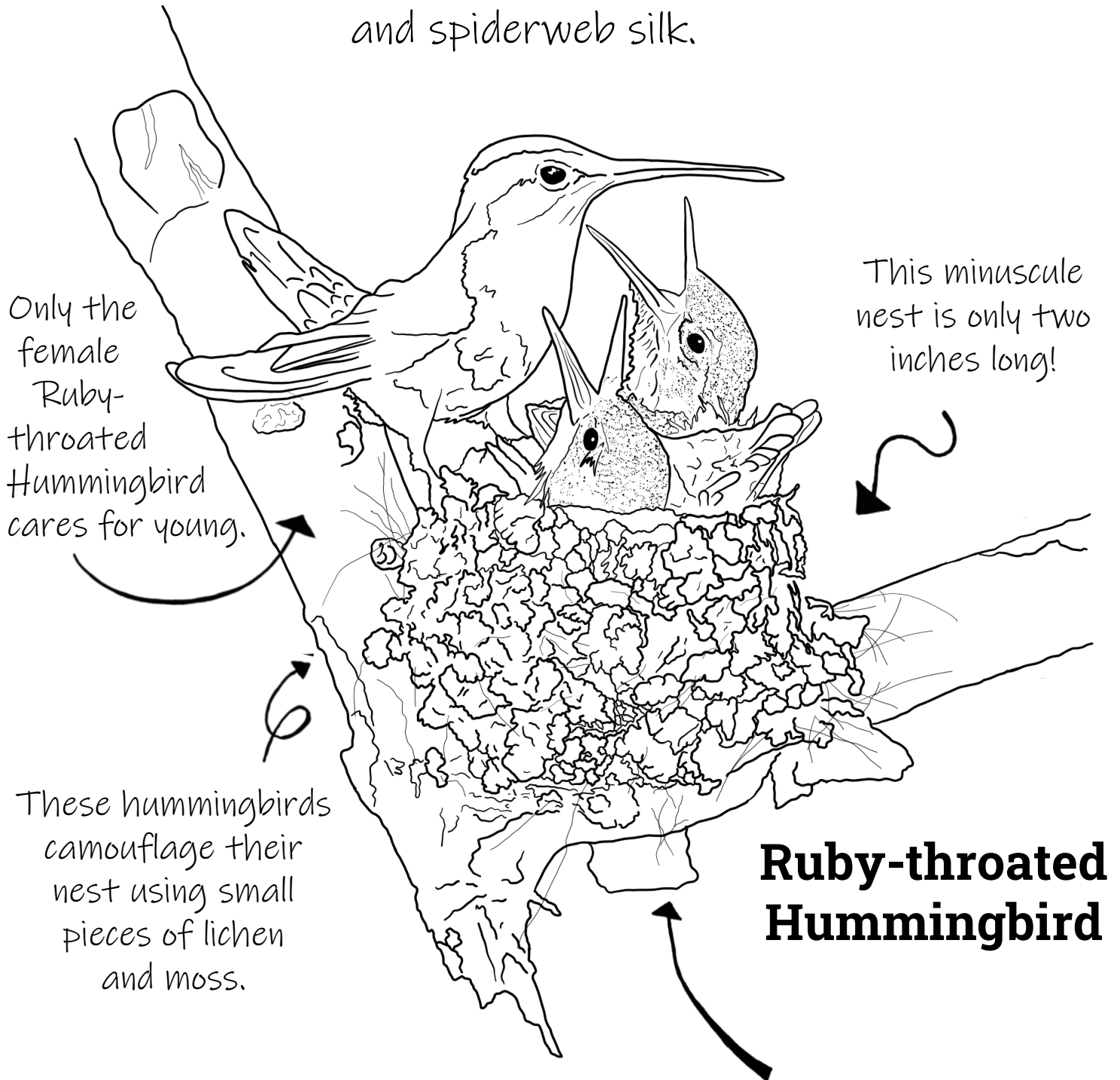


Get to Know: Bird Nests

This Ruby-throated Hummingbird's tiny nest is made of plant material, pine resin, lichen, moss and spiderweb silk.



Only the female Ruby-throated Hummingbird cares for young.

This minuscule nest is only two inches long!

These hummingbirds camouflage their nest using small pieces of lichen and moss.

The nest is held together with strands of silk from a spider web.



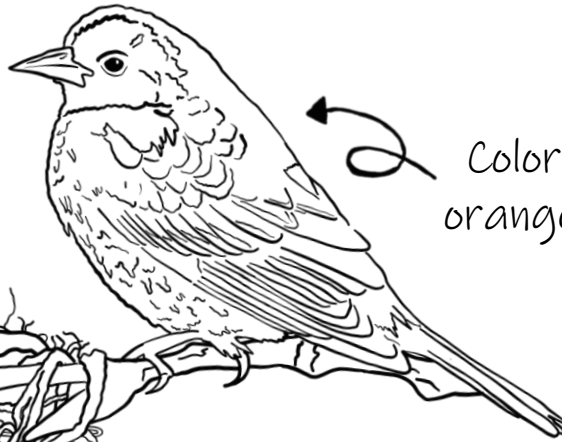

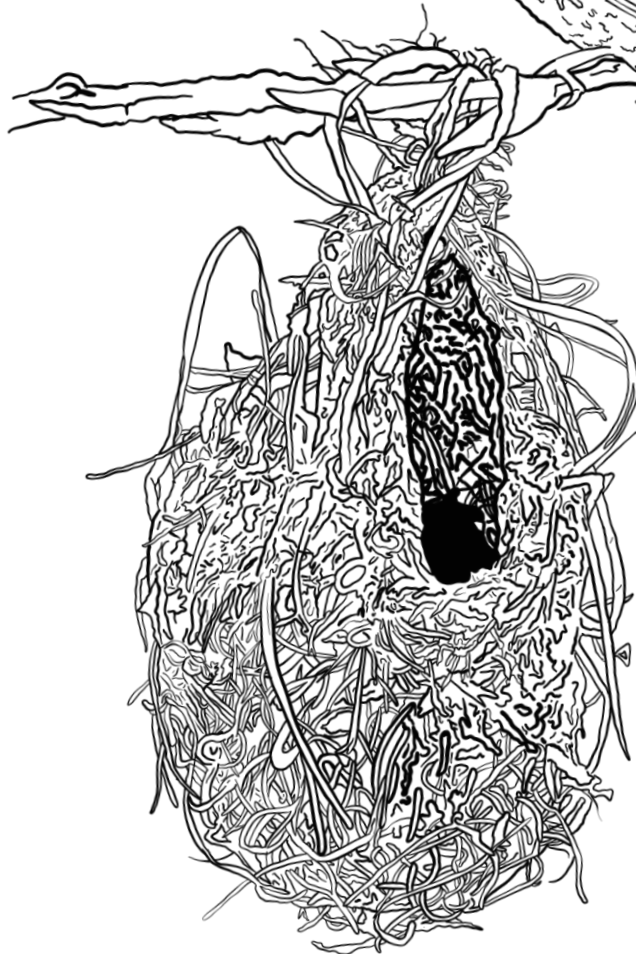
Birds and Their Nests

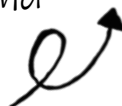
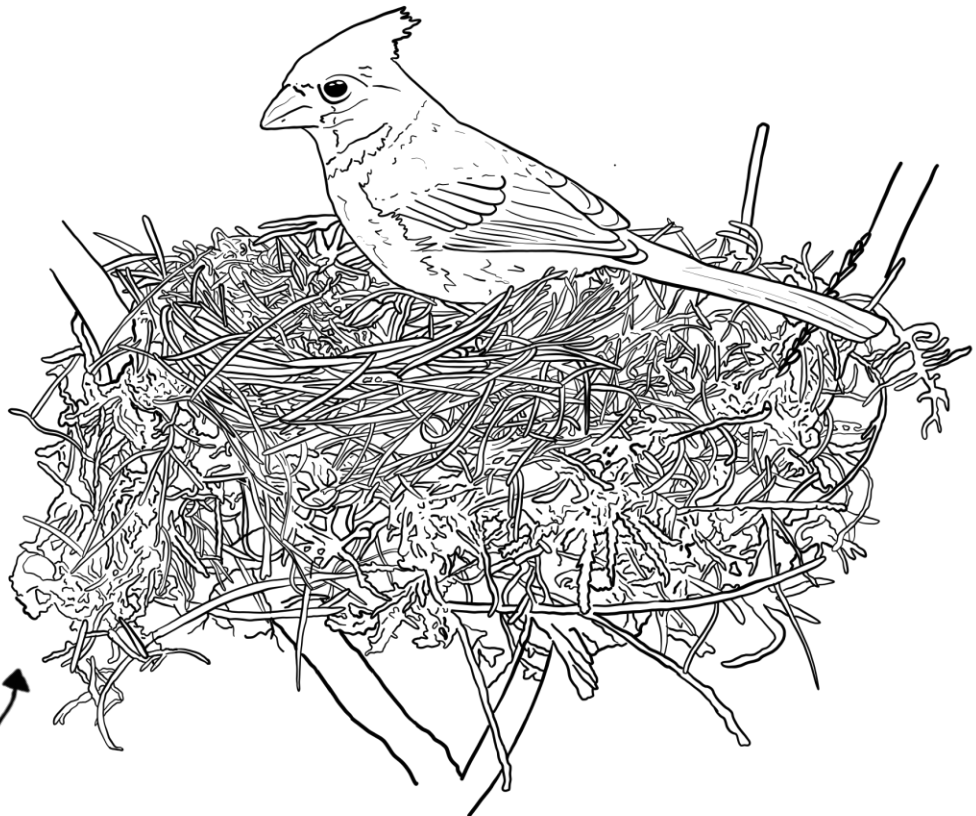
Pileated Woodpecker
