

Get to Know: Mambourg Park



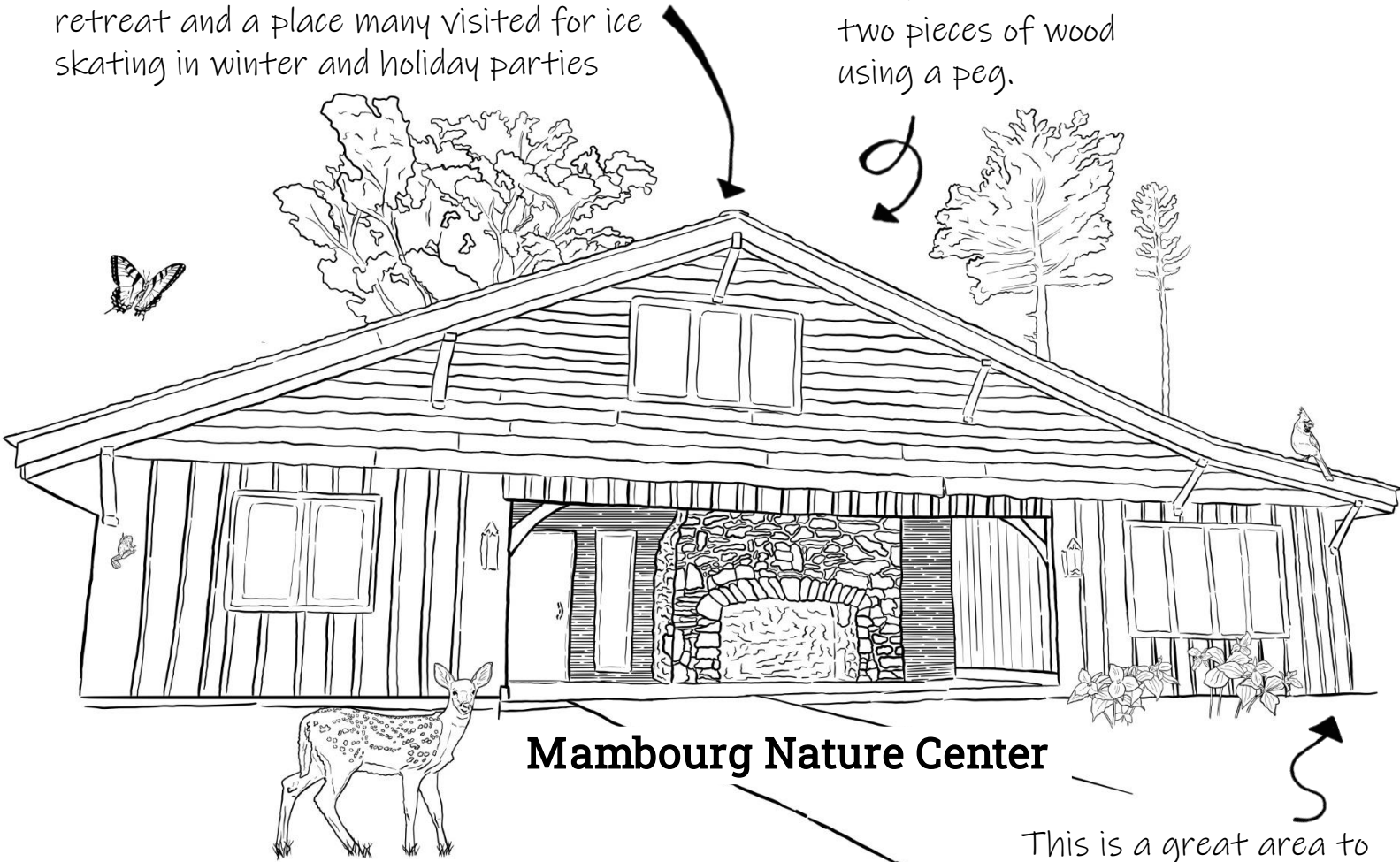
Welcome to Mambourg Park! There is much to see and learn.

two pieces of wood
using a peg.

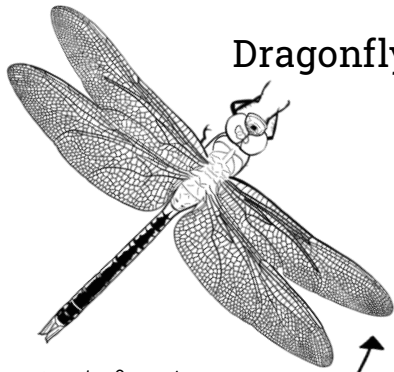

A hummingbird can flap its wings up to 70 times a second!



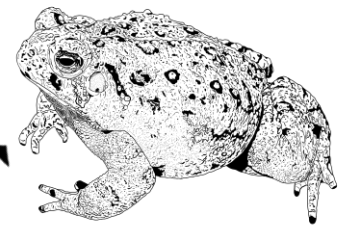
Raccoon

Raccoons are nocturnal and usually search for food at night.

Call is typically described as 'WHO-COOKS-FOR-YOU, WHO-COOKS-FOR-YOU-ALL!'

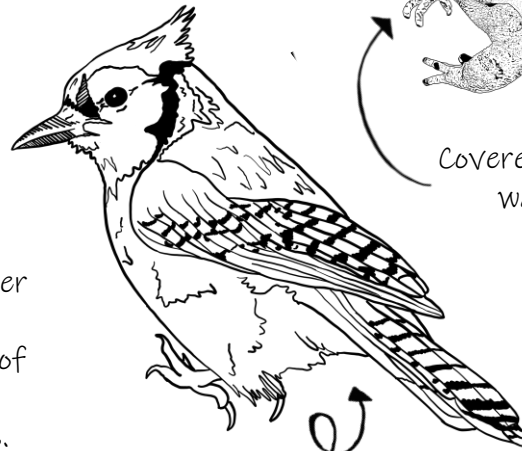
American Toad



Covered in hundreds of warty bumps.

Eastern Chipmunk

These rodents normally gather food on the ground, in areas with plenty of cover to hide from predators.



Blue Jay

Named for its loud call of 'Jay! Jay! Jay!'

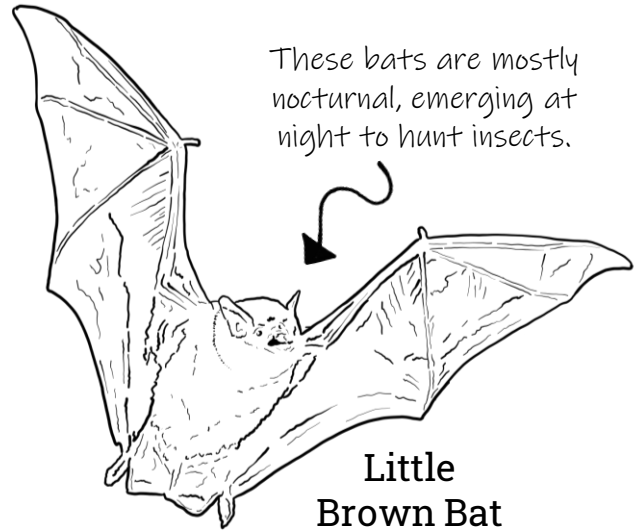
There are many amazing creatures to discover around Mambourg Park!

Eastern Cottontail



Very skittish, these rabbits prefer open habitats with plenty of area to hide from predators.

These bats are mostly nocturnal, emerging at night to hunt insects.



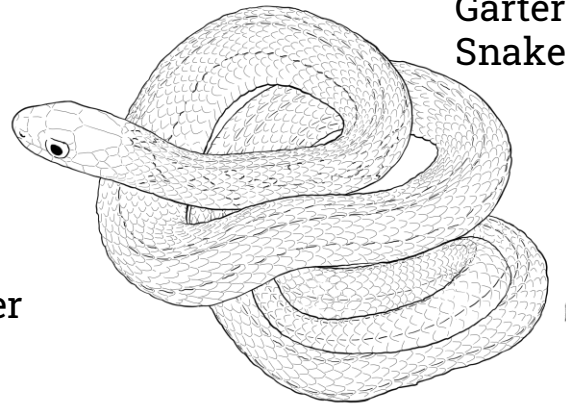
Little Brown Bat

Downy Woodpeckers are common in forested areas and around bird feeders.

Garter Snake



This harmless species is often miscalled a "garden snake," instead of garter snake.

These deer feed on a variety of different plants. They are crepuscular, meaning they are typically active around dawn and dusk.

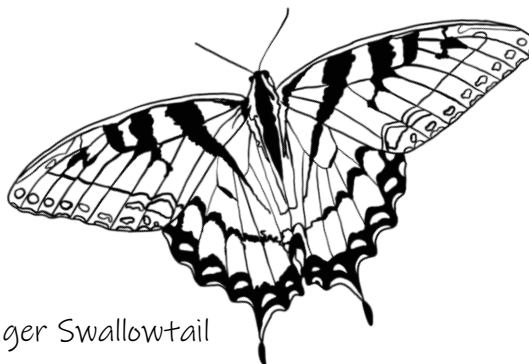


White-tailed Deer
